Not only content with releasing their own solo material, including Kotey's Afrobutt CD on Electric Minds and Essa's 12" releases and forthcoming album on Bear Funk; the pair have also been working together on their new project Soiree. In addition their first Salon De L'Herbe EP was released via Electric Minds in May 2008 providing a twisted journey of dub, disco and electronica and given the thumbs up world-wide by today's elite producers & DJs .

The standard continues with the 2nd EP, which sticks to the same theme in providing three deep and underground cuts. The live drums, guitars and slick arrangement provide a musical journey that sounds immense when piped through any decent club system.

"1986" will provide a great vibe for any club while "1978 It Felt Great" & "Guitar's" Balearic feel will be perfect for this summer. All in all three amazing tracks !
